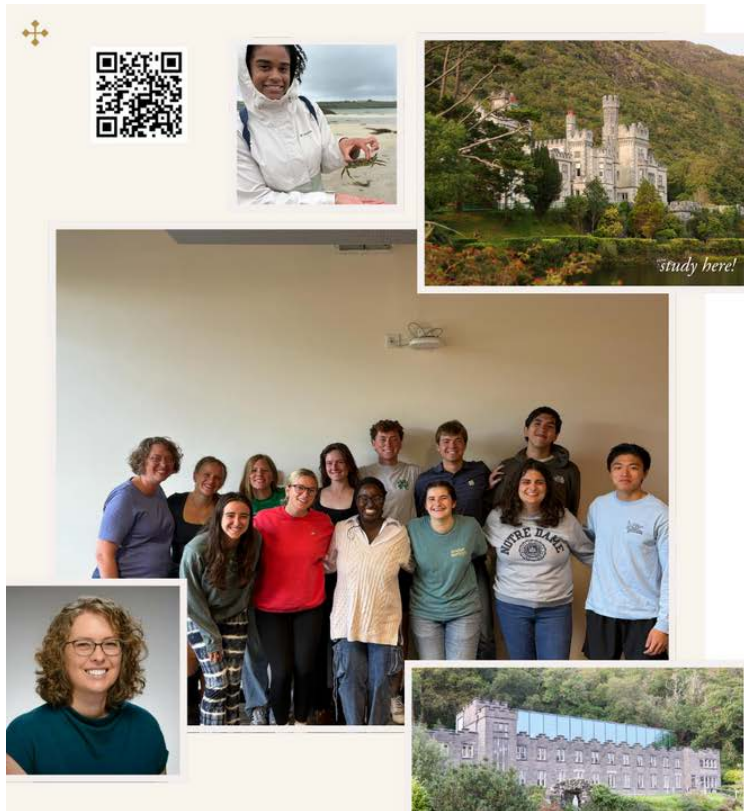

A Word from Dr. Lang: "The world needs the insights of scholars and teachers to address the challenges we face around the globe, but too much academic writing never passes beyond the boundaries of a narrow audience. I want to help experts reach more readers with their great ideas. As I have argued in my most recent book, we can expand the audiences for our research and ideas if we approach our writing projects as *teachers*, applying the insights of great classroom teaching to the page. The participants who join me in Kylemore Abbey will receive three great gifts that will benefit any writer: new skills for their writing toolkit, feedback on their current projects from me and their peers, and--most importantly--time to think, dream, and write in a gorgeous setting!"

Faculty Research Accelerator Program

The Naughton Fellowships [Faculty Research Accelerator Program](#) supports collaborations between faculty at the leading research universities of Ireland and the University of Notre Dame in order to advance collaborative

research and foster deeper and stronger ties between the institutions and the two countries. The program supports collaborative research at the highest level of excellence in the STEM fields.

Proposals may request up to \$120,000 USD in funding. This amount is to be split between the institutions included in the proposal. To facilitate joint research, a variety of uses may be proposed. For example, the program will support joint Notre Dame/Irish research programs with budgets that include supplies, equipment, and trainee support, as well as travel for faculty seeking to develop new collaborative research programs.

All applications are due by Friday, April 10, 2026.

NDG invites proposals that aim to deepen research and institutional connections between the global locations, institutions in their regions, and Notre Dame faculty.

Several of the grants offer funds for travel to the global location. Some grants also offer support for ND faculty to bring collaborators from the global location to South Bend, to help further research endeavors and/or enhance collaborators' understanding of the University.

Funding requests can be made up to **\$10,000, with additional funding available with the Jerusalem grant.**
